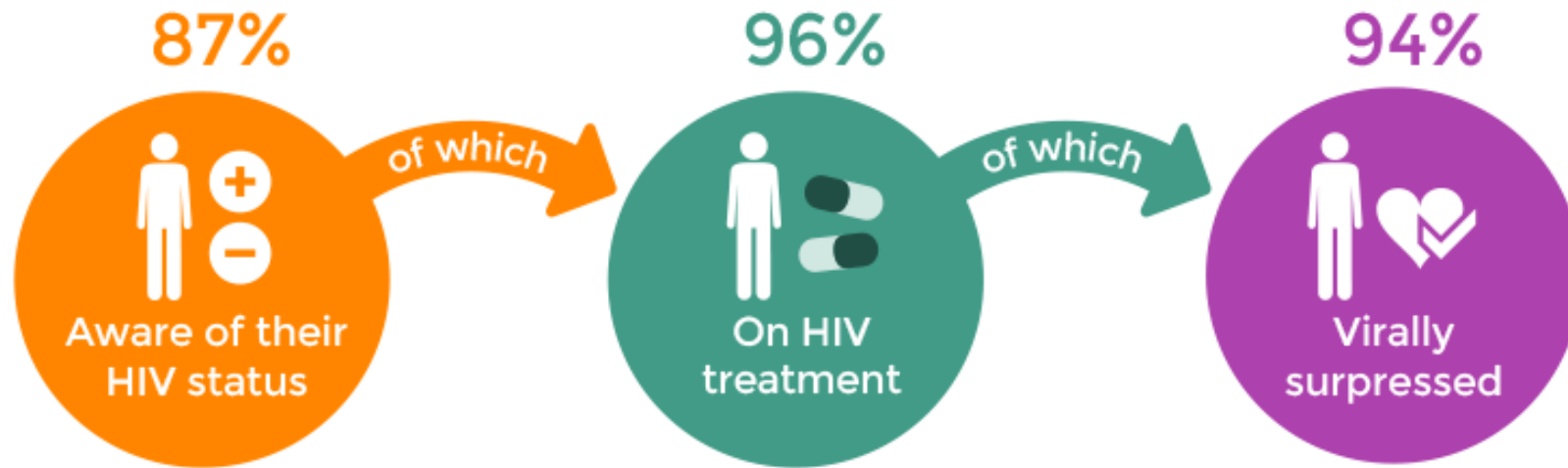

Progress towards 90/90/90 targets for 2020



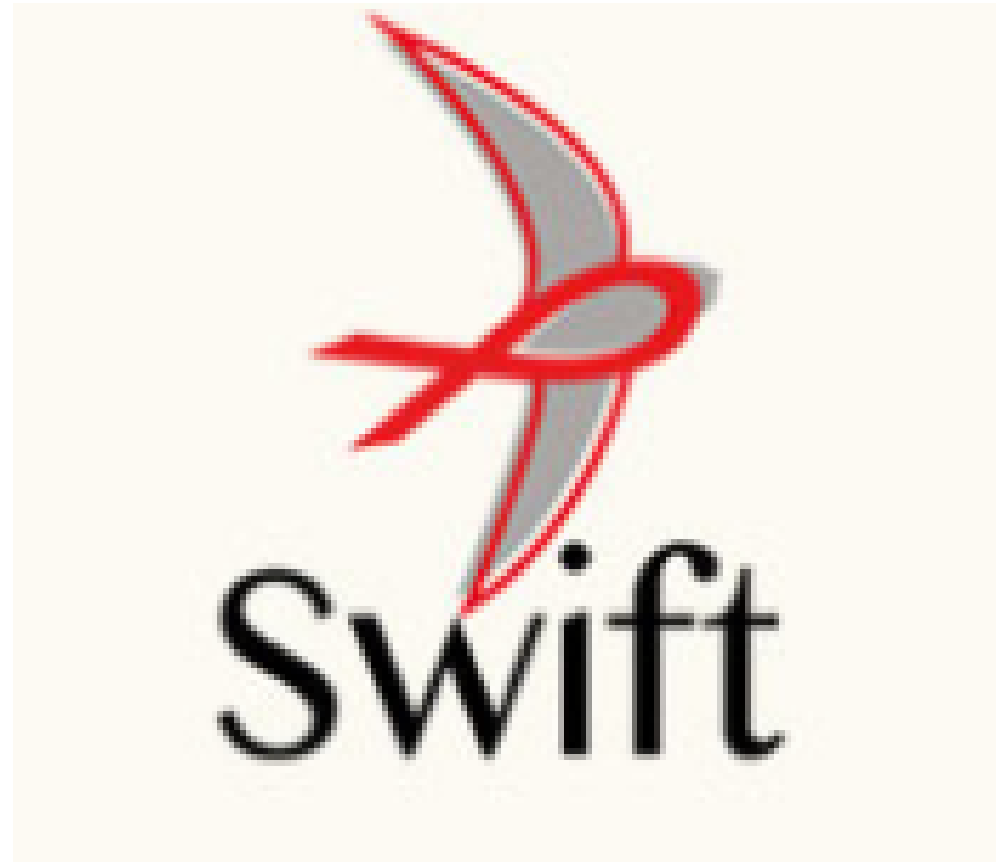
