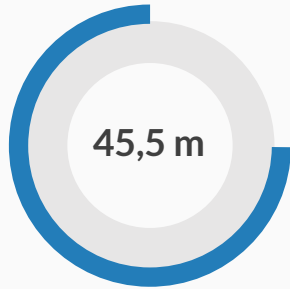


Teenenergizer — is a movement that united teenagers of Ukraine, Georgia, Russia and the whole region of Eastern Europe and Central Asia.

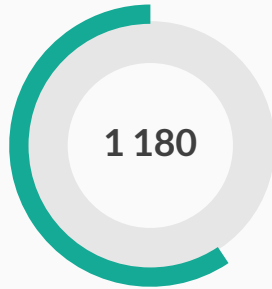

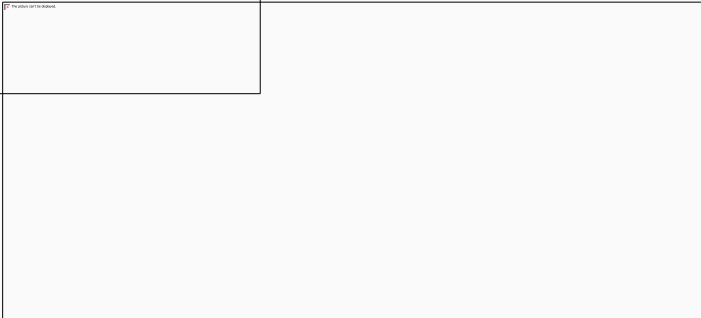
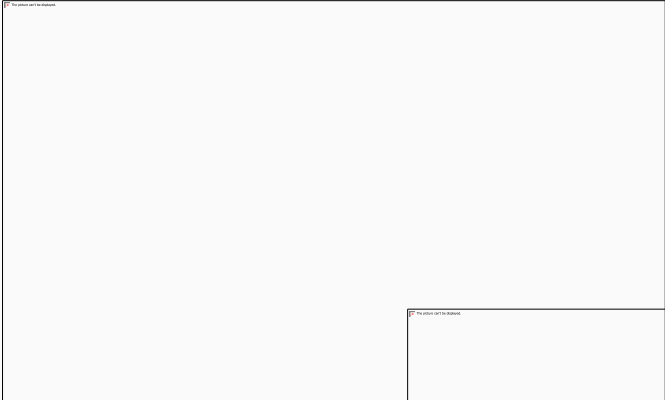
Young people to be accurately informed about HIV and the significance of HIV testing

Main challenges faced by adolescents affected by HIV in countries of EECA:

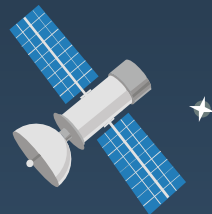
- Frequent interruptions of antiretroviral treatment for HIV + adolescents
- Late disclosure of HIV + status to children/adolescents
- Lack of services / approaches, friendly to adolescents
- Lack or gaps in peer to peer support, weak “voice of adolescents”
- Lack or gaps in peer support among parents
- Barriers in adolescents HIV testing related to legislation. Lack of awareness among adolescents (fear to take the HIV test, lack of knowledge among adolescents where to take the test)



Why do we face it?

- Barriers in adolescents HIV testing related to legislation. Lack of awareness among adolescents (fear to take the HIV test, lack of knowledge among adolescents where to take the test)
- Interests and needs of adolescents are not reflected in HIV policies
- Lack of financial support to teens initiatives / adolescents program
